There are several annual events coming up that you all should be aware of: May 1st -Service Day June 3-9 -PR week Sept 1- Unity Day Dec 1- Sponsorship Day The workshop topic was over MAT/DRT(medication assisted treatment/drug replacement therapy). Great information was shared! A resonating theme was to have a welcoming attitude, practice open-mindedness, carry a clear NA message and meet the addict where they are at, because we want them to keep coming back. Information that was gathered was turned into world for input on the new pamphlet that is coming soon. You can also have input for this topic by going online to NA.ORG. It is due by May 15, 2019. I attended the literature review sub-committee and was able to be part of input for the new Mental Health IP. You can access this IP in review form and put your input in as well on NA.ORG. We also discussed the Spiritual Principle A Day book. There are 9 principle that you can participation on until June, then at that time World will remove these principles and add 9 more to discuss. 


