- Discussed Tara K. resume for PR chair and decided to take the vote to the groups to waive her clean time before she can submit her resume to area. If groups vote to waive clean time requirement of 2 years she will then submit her resume at the August meeting and groups will have to vote for her and GSR’s will bring that vote back in September. (Much discussion was had and this was the consensus of the attending area members)

## NEW BUSINESS

- **AASC chair position open – bring resumes to the August OASC meeting.**

AASC Chair duties include but are not limited to:

- Will attend and participate at all OASC and AASC committee meetings. (AASC meetings are held same day as area – typically 2pm)
- Will be familiar with the sub committee’s current activities.
- Will oversee/host the Chili Cookoff (November), New Year’s Eve function (New Year’s Eve), Area Birthday function (May) and High On Life Picnic (typically last weekend in July)
- Shall have a report including itemized receipts and disbursements to date at every meeting of the AASC along with projected expenses for the upcoming month, an accurate inventory of available merchandise and the amount of funds available.
  - Will report at monthly OASC meetings the previous month’s total expenses, receipts and current checking balance of the AASC.
  - May sell merchandise prior to the activities with all proceeds being deposited in the AASC checking account through the Treasurer.
  - With agreement of 2 AASC sub committee chairs, shall remove any AASC member in the case of loss of clean time, consistent non-attendance, non-performance of duties, or criminal activity of any kind within the subcommittee’s domain. In the case of the Chair or Treasurer, the OASC shall remove them. Such member may be reinstated at the next scheduled meeting.
  - Shall appoint a substitute candidate to the subcommittee for any member removed for cause or resignation.
- Will be responsible for keeping records of all pre-registration and registrations
- Shall distribute 1 pre-registration to any NA function within the Ozark Area prior to the picnic, and may include 1 merchandise item when available.
- Will work with the Entertainment Chair to create a program of events,
- Will find people to chair all meetings at the picnic.

- **Motion to waive clean time for Tara K. to submit her resume for PR chair. This requirement is 2 years and her clean date is April 2022. Groups will vote on this and if she passes she will submit her resume at area in August.**

What is PR? Public Relations informs the public about recovery from the disease of addiction through the Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions of Narcotics Anonymous. It provides community awareness of what NA is, as well as how, when, and where we are available. We accomplish this by the phone line and sharing information about Narcotics Anonymous to the community, and by working with our Regional PR chair.

The following points are goals that we can strive to fulfill in making NA a visible and attractive choice for addicts:

1. We clarify what services NA can and cannot provide to the community.
2. We make NA members more aware of their role in NA's public image.
3. We aim for the public to recognize NA as a positive and reliable organization.
4. We develop valuable relationships with professionals and the general public.

- **AREA GUIDELINES-** If your group does not have a copy, please tell the secretary or chair and we will make sure you get one emailed to you. We will have a printed copy at each area for the VICE CHAIR to use, if you need to see that copy, please ask Vice Chair's permission.
- **Active** means you have been at 2 consecutive Area Business meetings.
- **Inactive** means you have missed 2 consecutive Area Business meetings. If you are active then your group will sit out of voting for ONE Area meeting, then the NEXT area meeting (in a row) your group is eligible to vote.
  - If you MISS the next area meeting, you are again inactive and must sit out another area business meeting.

- Voting privileges are regained at the *second consecutive area business* meeting your group is represented at.
- **GSR responsibilities** are to attend area business meetings, the GSR alternate should also attend to learn the process. The GSR Alternate may represent the group in the absence of the GSR at the Area business meeting.
  - If a GSR and GSR Alternate are not available to attend an area business meeting, any trusted servant may be sent by the group to represent them at the area, bringing the group information and *returning with area information for the group*.
- **Any member of Narcotics Anonymous may make a motion** at the Area Business meeting, however a GSR *must second* the motion in order for it to be considered for a vote. If it is not seconded by a GSR the chair will call it “dead for lack of second”. This does not mean it cannot be resubmitted, it just means that it didn’t get the second that it needed to be considered for a vote by the area.
- **Review or make available** the entire minutes that you receive each month with your home group, make sure there isn’t anything missing in your information exchange to the area and from the area. If you have questions about the minutes, ask the secretary, chair or vice-chair, they will be happy to help you!

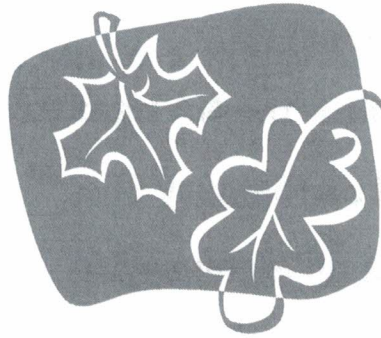

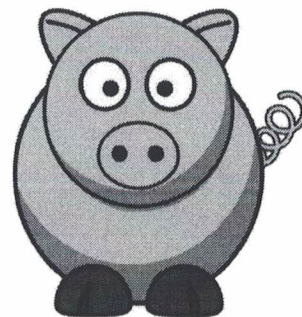
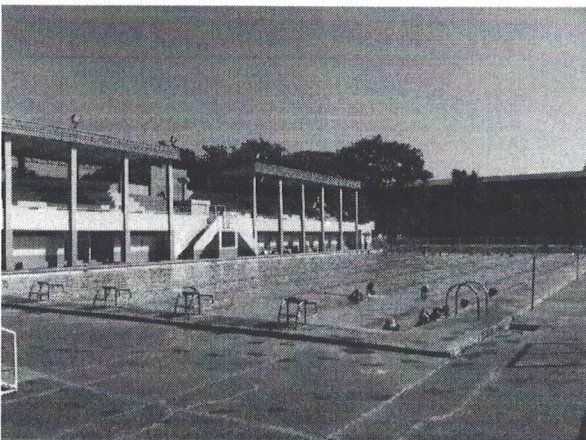
