- **Motion:** Add to the Ozark Area treasurer guidelines that money for each function be counted by the treasurer and chair and signed by both parties. In the event that one of these trusted servants aren't available, the vice chair would fill in. **This motion passed.**

- **Motion:** To move 2015 High on Life Picnic to a different location and appoint the AASC for an Ad-Hoc committee to find a location to be set by Nov. AASC. **This motion passed.**

NEW BUSINESS

- Budgets:
 - H & I: I looked at last year's budget for H & I and I had \$800.00 and had spent \$617.44 and \$182.56 left over. I think \$800.00 is enough for the 2014-2015 year so I am keeping my budget at \$800.00. –Brian C., H & I Chair
 - RCM: The R.C.M. budget for last year was \$900.00. If you look at the budget report that Amanda R. gave us last month the R.C.M. budget was \$900.00. As of last month we had spent \$1034.19. As of then we were \$134.19 over budget. Since last month we went to the regional meeting again and spent another \$190.18 taking us to \$324.37 over budget. I am asking for an increase of \$350.00 for a new total of \$1250.00. I am also asking that we double our Regional donation from \$200.00 to \$400.00 (\$100.00 per quarter). -Ed H., RCM
 - Secretary: \$250 (increase of \$50). Trying to cut down on costs by emailing minutes.
 - Treasurer: Keep at \$75
 - General Area Expenses: This includes the P.O. Box and area storage. Raise budget to \$450. This will also allow our area to buy a new coffee pot for area functions.
 - Public Relations (P.I): We've added a lot of new groups which means more literature and IPs to buy for these new groups, probation offices, treatment centers, etc. We spend about \$80 a month on the phone line and meeting copies. Raise the P.R. budget from \$900 to \$1600.
- **Vote at November's OASC on these budgets. Groups need to vote on these before next OASC:**
 - Public Relations (Information): **\$1600** (Increase of \$700)
 - Web Master: **\$150** (Decrease of \$50)
 - Hospitals and Institutions: **\$800** (Same as last year's budget)
 - Regional Committee Member: **\$1250** (Increase of \$350)
 - Secretary: **\$250** (Increase of \$50)
 - Treasurer: **\$75** (Same as last year's budget)
 - Literature: **\$0** (Same as last year's budget)
 - Outreach: **\$100** (Same as last year's budget)
 - General Area Expenses: **\$450** (Increase of \$300)
 - Regional Donation: **\$400** (Increase of \$200, **see motion below**)
 - **Total Budget: \$5075** (Increase of \$1550)

****Motion**:** Increase the Ozark Area's quarterly donation to the Show Me Region to \$100 from \$50, doubling the annual donation to \$400. **This motion to be voted on next month.**

Next meeting: The next meeting is on November 16 at House Inc. at 24706 Highway 171 in Joplin, MO hosted by Stray Katz. P.I. subcommittee at 12:00 and business meeting starts at 3:00.


