SHARING SESSION

- Ed didn't do PR workshop because there is a lot to that. We Do does not charge if they do a workshop in their building. We need a chairperson from each subcommittee to speak at a **workshop on service work and unity**. We need to let people know what Narcotics Anonymous is all about. Since not all chair people are present, Ed will discuss this at next month's area meeting.
- Mark J. asked Raymond if, when Outreach goes to **Nevada**, he will ask that group if they still want to be a part of this area because they have not been here for 5 months. Another person suggested that Raymond might want to attend the business meeting to find out if they still want to be a part of our area. Crystal W. thought that maybe we could contact their GSR to find out when their business meeting is.
- Springfield has a **phone line** that runs somewhat different than ours. They have 6-7 people who have the phone line attached to their phone so multiple people can answer the phone line. Mark J. would be willing to find out how their phone line works. Since we have the phone line bills straightened out, maybe we shouldn't change services.
- Mike O. has not heard anything from Jessica related to the **Seneca meeting**. Mike O. can call her.
- Pam hopes that each group is letting the newcomers know how amazing NA functions are. We should be inviting newcomers to functions, campouts, out-of-town meetings, etc. The Show Me Region of Narcotics Anonymous has a convention every other year. **SMRCNA** is October 17-19 this year. - Questions were raised about the **inactive groups** preventing us from conducting new business: If people are often not present to vote, then why are we continuing to count them as a group in the quorum? How can we be accountable if we are relying on groups who are not accountable? Can we change the quorum rules as to how people vote? Mike O. shared that the guidelines would have to be changed pertaining to the quorum.
- Pam read the 5.5 guideline out of the Ozark Area Service Guidelines as follows:
 - The OASC may conduct all business provided 2/3 of the groups on the Active List are represented. In the event quorum cannot be met, items of business may be executed provided 2/3 of the OASC empower present GSR's to vote on such items. Each item to be called to a vote must be authorized separately.
- The following 4 items of business were executed because 2/3 of the OASC empowered present GSR's to vote on these items. Each item was authorized separately.
 - Brian C. is appointed as **H & I Chair**.
 - Ed H. is appointed as **Regional Committee Member (RCM)**.
 - Ali D. is appointed as **Secretary**.
 - Raymond M. is appointed as **Outreach Chair**.

NEW BUSINESS

- **Motion:** To change Article 2 in the guidelines to read as follows:
 - The service area shall include all Narcotics Anonymous Groups within Ozark Area. The service area of the OASC may roughly be geographically defined as North of the Missouri/Arkansas border; East of the Missouri/Kansas border; South of the United Kansas City Area of N.A.; and West of the Southwest Missouri Area of N.A., **but not limited to**.
 - The intent is to keep some boundaries to our area but it does not limit us to these boundaries.
- Give Ed the votes for all **regional trusted servant positions** at the next area meeting in June or before. See April's minutes for the resumes for all these positions.

Next meeting: The next meeting is on June 15, 2014 at We Do Recover. We Do Recover will host. Subcommittees begin at 12:30 and the business meeting is at 3:00

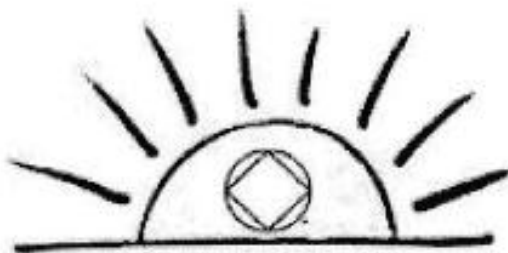

Directions to Camp Rising Sun- Kaiser, MO.

Once you are at the lake: Take U.S. Hwy 54 to Hwy 42 go east on Hwy 42 about 4 miles, turn onto Hwy 134 (at the Lake of the Ozarks State Park Entrance.) Continue on Hwy 134 about 1 mile, turn right onto Whispering Oak Rd. (*just* past a small log cabin information booth.) Continue on Whispering Oak Rd. for about 3 miles. Turn left into Camp Rising Sun!
