## RCM Report October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2023

Hello Ozark Area-

I am an addict named Ginette serving as you RCM. I apologize for my absence at Area today, I am participating in the Pumpkin Run in Carthage today that my work is sponsoring to benefit Community Support Services here in Joplin.

Lots of great things worked out at this quarters Regional meeting. The outcome of the votes we took back from the previous Region are as follows:

All position applicants were voted in except for Martin D for literature chair. He removed his resume for consideration.

**Motion 1** regarding position changes and bank account changes happening prior to the following RSC from being voted in **passed**.

**Motion 3** regarding adding bank account information to the Region FB account was actually **rescinded** by the RSC body due to inaccuracies in how it was made to appear that it was a requirement by FB to do so to have control of the page and that not being the case.

**Motion 4** regarding the vice chair moving to chair after completion of term with a vote of confidence by the RSC **passed**

**Motion 5** regarding extending the RD and AD terms to mirror WSC cycle commitments **passed**

**Motion 6** regarding cleaning up guideline wording **passed**.

We still have some **open positions** at the Region level. Looking for people in this area that may want to step back into service work. Secretary is still open and very much needed as soon as possible. I plan to nominate Laura T from our Area at the next Region. She has service as RCMA and RCM as well as service on AASC and has held numerous positions within We Do Recover. She has agreed to put in her resume. The Region is also in need of a Literature Chair. The requirements are 3 yrs continuous clean time, an active member of NA with a working knowledge of the steps, traditions, concepts, the guide to local service and the Show Me Region guidelines. They would like that person to have been an active member of that subcommittee previously but it is not a requirement.

In new business we went over budget proposals for the upcoming fiscal year. All the subcommittees and executive committee members worked hard at lowering budgets in any way possible and, even with the continually rising costs everyone is experiencing, we were able to drop the budget from where it was previously at **\$65,636** all the way down to **\$45,612**. I still found several accounting errors in their budgeting however, which I plan to rework through next week to present for correction at the next Region (the actual number is even lower than the amount quoted above - more to be revealed).

There were new motions put in for the home groups to vote on and they are as follows:

**Motion 20231015-01**

The motion reads as follows:

To update guideline section 6.2.G which currently states "Copies of bank statements will be presented with the Treasure's report at RSC meetings" to reflect "Copies of any and all itemized financial statements are to be presented with the Treasure's report at the RSC meetings"

**Intent:**

To ensure there will be transparency for current amounts as well as future accounts that this body has previously voted to utilize or may utilize in the future that is not currently transparent.

**Motion 20231015-02**

The motion reads as follows:

To change current guidelines to reflect an update on Section 9 heading. Current heading states "File Platform Sharing Guidelines" and the update will state "File Platform Sharing and Social Media Guidelines". An additional item also added which will be labeled "M" and will state "Any and all social media presence will be managed by the PR Subcommittee and will adhere to normal password and transparency guidelines as other Show Me Region Accounts."

**Intent:**

To have proper social media accountability and a single point of accountability in line with NA concept number five.

**Motion 20231015-03**

The motion reads as follows:

To change current guideline 6.3.A which currently states "All expenditures made by the committee will be paid by check" to now state "No expenditures for the committee will be made in cash".

**Intent:**

Currently expenditures are being paid by check and debit card so this will clean up guidelines to reflect the need for traceability while avoiding the possibility of bad practices by trusted servants.

A few other items I would like you all to back to your groups to present at the next Area meeting so I can channel the answers up to the Regional level:

**Our Outreach Region Chair would like to know:**

- 1) **What is one thing our Area does really well?**

I would also like to have our Writing Steps to Recovery Region Chair to come down and give a workshop on that subcommittee. With the increasing interest in H&I efforts in our Area, I feel like this is a similar service work area that would benefit our Area members as well as those behind the walls interested in working steps. This process is about to get a whole lot easier than previous years also due to the influx of availability for tablets in different jails and prisons in Missouri. With the holidays coming quickly I thought maybe we could hold it at 12pm on the next Area meeting date in November and if not that date then we could wait until after the holidays and worst of the winter weather and hold it at 12pm before the Area meeting in February. So, if you don't mind holding a vote today during new business as to if you would like to have a workshop on this topic; then if that passes vote on the November or February date and let me know what the outcome of those votes are.

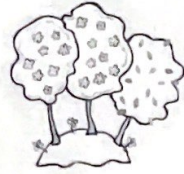
