A motion was made and seconded regarding our funds at the regional level. The motion reads as follows: To task the RSC to set aside \$2,000 per year to help struggling areas to make it to the RSC by having two paid rooms available, one for men and one for women; and to help with funds for gas not to exceed \$50 per area, per region. Intent: To help areas attend the RSC which in turn gets the necessary information to those groups in that area and helps carry the message. *Note*: This is separate from the regional motion (attached) that seeks to send world donations quarterly instead of annually.
